Place large white sheets over a table. Create an opening. Place a large white sheet on the floor. Place pots, pans, pretend food, a fishing rod, plastic fish, blankets, mittens, scarf, hat, etc. Let children pretend to live in the igloo and go outside to go ice fishing.

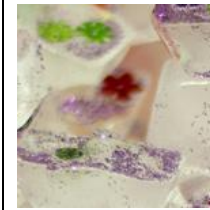

Fine Motor Skills:

Frozen

Let children transfer cotton balls or small items such as beads, buttons, craft foam snowflakes, etc. with a tweezers from a bowl in to ice cube freezer compartment. Add some water and freeze. Let children explore melting the ice cubes with the help of salt to remove the frozen items.



Block Center:

Elsa's Ice Castle

Add Styrofoam cups, and clear white plastic cups in different sizes to your block center. Let children create an ice castle. Add glass gems, snowflake stickers, mirror discs, pine cones, foam snowflakes, white sheer fabric, and white felt.

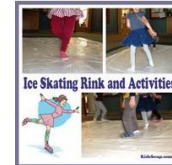
